## SPUMANTE

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### PROSECCO 13/58

Bisol 'Jeio', Brut, Veneto NV

*green apple and citrus notes, with a dry, mineral backbone and an intensely persistent bubble*

### LAMBRUSCO 15/68

La Battagliola 'Grasparossa', Modena 2023

*lively, dry red sparkling wine from Northern Italy with notes of bright, crisp cranberry and a complex, lingering finish*

### FRANCIACORTA 110

Antica Fratta 'Essence' Rosé, Lombardy 2018

*Italy's answer to Champagne, this rosé traditional method sparkler is luscious with notes of underripe strawberry and green almond*

### CHAMPAGNE 160

Taittinger 'Brut Francais', Champagne, France NV

*traditional method bubbles from the famed region in France: toasty aromas with an elegant perlage and a long, clean finish*

## BIANCO

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### PINOT GRIGIO 14/63

Elena Walch, Alto Adige 2023

*independent, family owned winery producing light style pinot grigio: dry, crisp, lip-smacking*

### GRILLO 15/68

Feudo Montoni 'Timpa', Sicily 2022

*strikingly similar to Sauvignon Blanc, Timpa means strong slope and this wine grows on a slope that exceeds a 70% gradient, preserving acidity and developing fruit*

### FALANGHINA 14/63

Michele Alois 'Caulino', Campania 2023

*volcanic soils from Mount Vesuvio and a terror-nerd for a winemaker makes for this delicately textured yet expressive Falanghina, a grape native to this region of Campania*

### SAUVIGNON BLANC 18/81

Abbazia di Novacella, Trentino Alto-Adige 2023

*reminiscent of green peppers, lemon zest, and acacia blossom; refreshing and lively on the palate*

### VERMENTINO 16/72

Mora e Memo 'Tino', Sardinia 2023

*100% vermentino from a legendary producer in Sicily, all stainless ferment; super crisp, saline, mineral-driven*

### CHARDONNAY 15/68

Sturm 'Andritz', Collio 2022

*organically farmed and a bit round while remaining well-balanced with ripe tropical fruit notes and mineral freshness*

### VERDICCHIO DEI CASTELLI JESI 65

Croce del Moro 'Moro della Genga', La Marche 2023

*zesty! fresh! mineral-driven and reminiscent of juicy citrus fruit and flakey sea salt. a lovely alternative to pinot grigio*

### VERNACCIA 90

Montenidoli 'Tradizionale', San Gimignano, Tuscany 2022

*iconic Tuscan white wine with its own DOCG: round and complex with notes of fennel and almond skin*

### ROERO ARNEIS 75

Angelo Negro 'Serra Lupini', Piedmont 2022

*notes of fleshy peach and white flowers lead this dry white wine, made by a family who has been cultivating this grape since 1670*

### KERNER 85

Klaus Lentsch, Trentino Alto Adige 2022

*a unique, aromatic grape related to both riesling and trollinger now common in this region of northern Italy. Dry on the palate with luscious tropical fruit notes and a long, balanced finish*

## ROSATO

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### CHIARETTO 15/68

Pasini San Giovanni, Valtenesi 2023

*from the shores of Lake Garda, this is a delicate and dry wine with notes of grapefruit pith and roses*

### LAGREIN 18/81

Cantina Kellerei Terlan, Alto Adige 2023

*an indigenous red grape, vinified as rosé! Soft yet juicy with notes of amarena cherry and a fresh, lengthy finish*

## RAMATO

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### PINOT GRIGIO 14/63

Le Monde, Friuli 2022

*skin-contact dry "orange" wine from the north; bright copper color, creamy texture, wild strawberries, apple, apricot*

## ROSSO

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### PINOT NOIR 18/81

Pojer e Sandri, Dolomiti 2023

*generously fruity with notes of raspberry marmalade and red cherry, silky tannins and an intricate finish.*

### NEBBIOLO 16/72

G.D. Vajra, Piedmont 2023

*pure, expressive nebbiolo from the Langhe DOC - expect violets, fresh red berries, and earthy spice*

### SANGIOVESE 17/77

Poggio la Noce 'Gigetto', Tuscany 2022

*modern yet serious sangiovese made with minimal influence: dry, tart cherries and tomato leaf with balanced tannins*

### MONTEPULCIANO D'ABRUZZO 14/63

Torre Raone, Abruzzo, 2022

*an excellent example of this indigenous variety from central Italy: ripe wild berries, sweet herbs, savory spice*

### NEGROAMARO 16/72

Trullo Flaminio, 'Brindisi', Puglia 2021

*intensely jammy black cherry notes with hints of underlying spice and tilled earth. Generously plush while retaining its freshness*

### CABERNET SAUVIGNON 19/86

Ciacci Piccolomini d'Aragona 'Ateo' Tuscany 2023

*certified organic Super Tuscan style wine with an intense, spicy bouquet and juicy black fruit notes*

### NEBBIOLO 90

Dirupi, 'Ole!', Lombardy 2022

*fresh strawberries and notes of violet lead this energetic, juicy, lighter style of nebbiolo. Expect silky tannins, zesty acidity, and an elegant finish*

### SCHIOPPETTINO 120

Ronchi di Cialla, Friuli-Venezia Giulia 2018

*a native grape from Friuli with notes of jammy red currants, vanilla, balsamic, and a hint of underbrush. Juicy and delicious*

### BRUNELLO DI MONTALCINO 160

Palazzone, Tuscany 2019

*Brunello at its most approachable: reminiscent of cranberry sauce, sweet tobacco, and smoky grilled meats. Extended oak aging contributes to this wine's vinous complexity*

### BAROLO 150

Marrone, Piedmont 2018

*a classic Barolo with a broad structure and notes of cremini mushrooms, black pepper, and a hint of florality*

### SUPERTUSCAN 160

Gaja, Ca' Marcanda 'Promis', Tuscany 2022

*grown right next to the ocean in Bolgheri, this wine is bold with velvety tannins and notes of black currant and warm baking spices*
